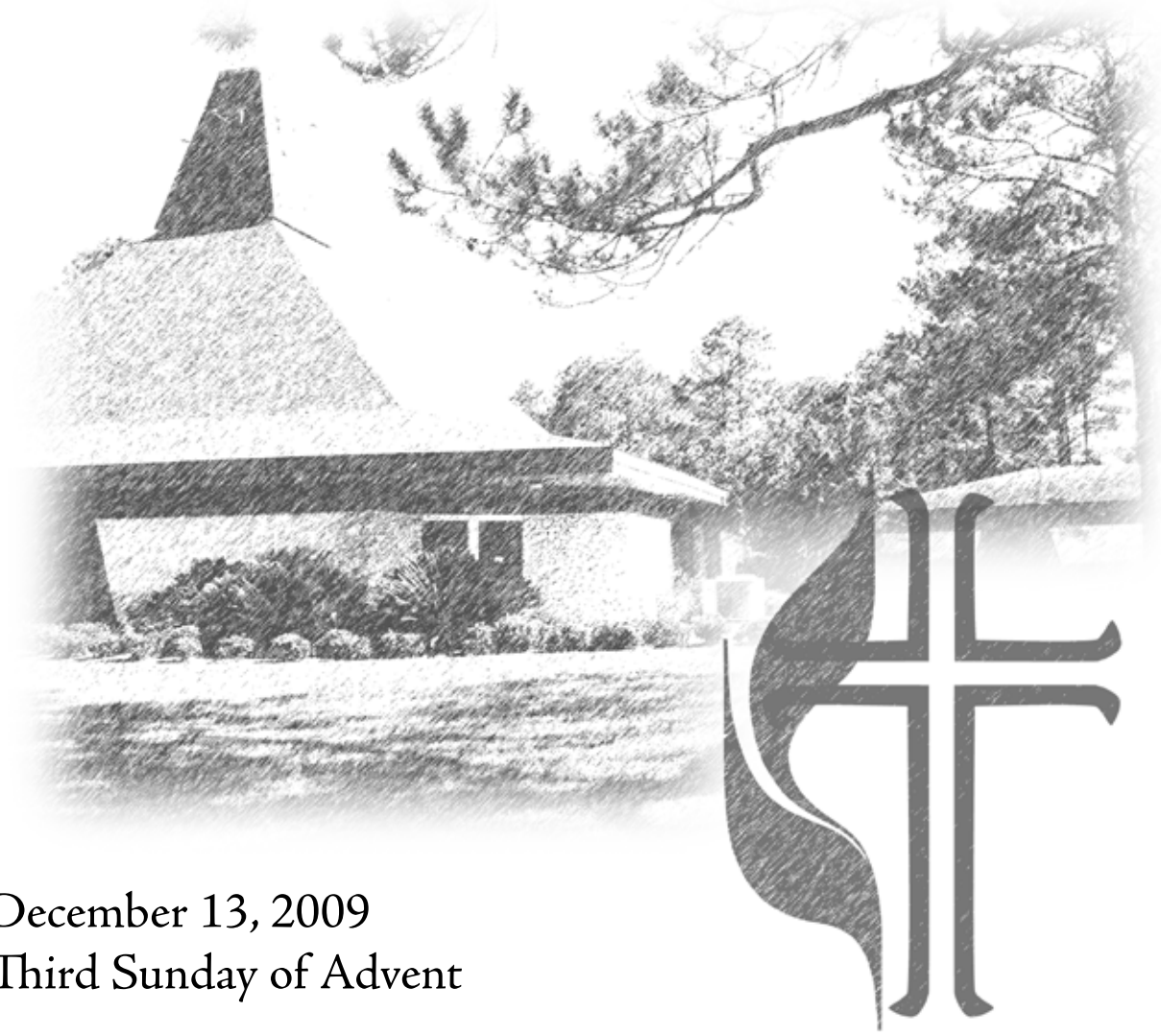
Stephen Ministry

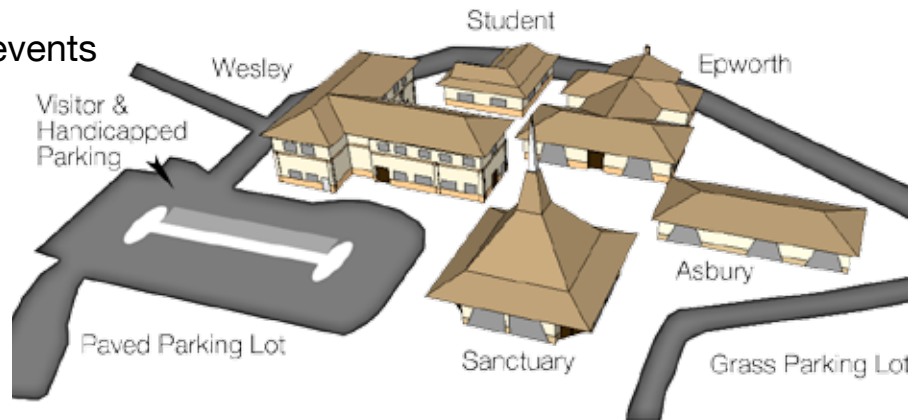
