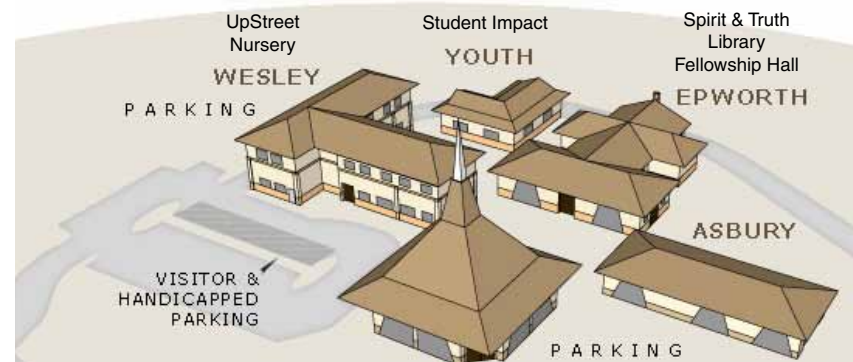

### UNLEASHING A DANGEROUS NEW IDEA

When Martin Luther placed his Ninety-five Theses on the Door of Wittenburg College, Germany, on Oct 31, 1517 he unleashed a dangerous new idea- that all Christians had the right to interpret the Bible for themselves, placing the Bible in the hands of the laity. Luther's theses circulated throughout Europe setting off a firestorm of a vast revolution bringing radical reform to the Christian Church known as The Protestant Reformation.

We Methodists are a protestant Church deeply indebted to the 16th century Reformers who have greatly influenced our theology, sacraments, liturgy, use of Scripture and teachings. All are welcome to come as we study The Reformation, beginning our second year of Studies in Church history. Jack Stroman and Bill Buck are the class leaders.
